

Year 7 History Trip: Monday 20th March 2023 – Warwick Castle

Dear Parent/Guardian,

All Year 7 students are being given the opportunity to visit Warwick Castle on Monday 20th March 2023.

During the trip, students will explore Warwick Castle, supplementing prior work done on castles and the Norman invasion of Britain, but also looking at future content students may study at GCSE History. Students will see battlements, towers, turrets and the Great Hall and visit interactive attractions and walk-through adventures such as the Horrible Histories Maze and Time Tower, where students learn about characters from the Castle's past. The trip will run within the timings of the normal school day, however students will need to be at school early to catch the coach. Students should bring a bag with a packed lunch and plenty of water and a pen (and a coat depending on the weather!). The group will be catching a coach at 09:00 and it is important that they meet in Big School by 08:45 at the latest so they can be registered with the supporting members of staff. On the day, it is imperative that if you know your son will be late that you phone the front office (01788 542074) as a matter of urgency. The coach will leave Warwick Castle at 14:15 to ensure students are back in school to catch their normal method of transport home.

We would be grateful for a contribution of £16.00 towards the cost of the trip. This covers the return coach journey to Warwick, entry into the site and cost of the resources to be used on the day. This payment should be made via **parentpay** or can be paid with a cheque. Please make cheques payable to Lawrence Sheriff School. No student will be denied participation in the visit because of difficulty in meeting the cost. However, the trip will only go ahead if sufficient contributions are received. Parents/Carers who are in receipt of Pupil Premium are exempt from paying the cost of the trip. The School may also be able to provide support to families who are experiencing difficult financial circumstances.
