First Word ... from the Deputy Headteacher, Teresa Mpofu

Data is now exchanged at a quite phenomenal rate. Every minute there are 204 000 000 emails sent, 12 hours of footage loaded to YouTube, and 277 000 tweets posted. Ninety percent of the world's data was created in the past 3 years with an estimated 50 000 GB of data generated per second. Despite this huge growth in data, data laws have not been updated since 1998 and therefore it was time for a review. The new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) comes into effect on May 25th 2018 and although the general principles are largely unchanged, GDPR does put greater emphasis on the rights of the individual and the responsibilities of organisations that collect and use data.

The principles state that data must be:

- Processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner.
- Collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes.
- Adequate, relevant and limited to the purposes for which it is processed.
- Accurate and up-to-date.
- Kept for no longer than is necessary.
- Processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security.

I would like to explain this more simply: we must know what data we collect, why we collect it, who we share it with, how we keep it safe, and how long we should keep it - we must then dispose of it safely when it is no longer required. We must also ensure that we explain to all data subjects how they can correct, update, erase and access information.

The vast majority of pupil data is available to parents via Insight, where parents can view data and ask us to amend it as needed. As part of our preparation for GDPR, Privacy Notices have been reviewed and rewritten and can be found attached to this newsletter, and on the [school website](#). We must also be more explicit when gaining consent for handling data. As such, we need to ask you all to complete new photographic permission slips – these will be sent home with your son and via Insight. This also means that communication between school and home is as important as ever, as students may miss out on opportunities if letters do not make their way home and reply slips do not get returned back to school.

I have spoken to the boys in assembly about the importance of looking after their data...they are growing up in a data-rich environment but still have the right to privacy.
